

The purpose of this psalm is to give thanks because the Lord has redeemed the people. The Lord has rescued the people from trouble, redeemed them from their enemies, and gathered them from the lands of exile. The people had been scattered but now returned. Those who are the redeemed of the Lord give Him thanks.

Friday: Psalm 108

"In Psalm 108 the psalmist is resolute in his belief that God remains faithful to his covenant people. In the opening line the psalmist indicates that his heart is steadfast and firm. From beginning to end the psalmist remains firm in his commitment and steadfast in his conviction concerning the faithfulness of Yahweh." - The NIV Application Commentary

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for the pastors in Nicaragua. Pray for strength, courage, and boldness to preach the word. Pray for their wives and families that they too would have strength. Finally, pray for the continued advance of the gospel throughout the country.

Monday: Psalm 104

The images expressed in Psalm 104:1-4 all show the magnificence of God, who created and rules the world. Therefore, meditate on the magnificence of God and praise Him, knowing that He is truly "very great!"

Tuesday: Psalm 105

Verses 7-11 of today's passage describe what the Lord has done in both making and keeping His covenants. The Lord does not make a covenant and then not keep it or forget about it. The Lord "remembers his covenant forever" (v. 8). Pray in thanksgiving to our God, who always keeps His covenants.

Wednesday: Psalm 106

"Praise the Lord! Oh give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever!" This verse is the first of many in Psalm 106, yet one needs to go no further than to stop and do what is written. Praise and give thanks to the Lord.




