Thursday: Psalm 92

“That though the wicked sprout like grass and all evildoers flourish, they are doomed to destruction forever” (v. 5). It may seem, at the moment, that those who do evil will prevail; it is only for a time. But, ultimately, it is God’s will alone that prevails (v. 9).

Friday: Psalm 93

Today’s psalm is a hymn of praise to God, which points to His divine kingship. Specifically, this psalm points to God’s kingly rule over creation. We know God is the Creator and therefore reigns over His creation. Being reminded of this helps us to give Him the honor and glory He deserves.

Saturday: Prayer

Our outreach prayer this week is for the Gospel Rescue Mission. Please pray for the financial and practical resources of the Mission. Pray that those needs are being met and continue to be met.

Monday: Psalm 89

The psalmist is singing about God's steadfast love and faithfulness. He is doing so because God displays these things to those who love Him. Consider all the ways God has shown His love to you. Think of all the promises He has and always will faithfully keep. Then pray and praise God who is worthy.

Tuesday: Psalm 90

God is the "dwelling place" (v. 1), the home and refuge for His people. This is because God is eternal. "From everlasting to everlasting" (v. 2). speaks to the Lord's eternity. This also serves as a reminder that God never changes. For the believer, our hope is not in something fleeting, but in the Lord, who more solid and secure than we could ever imagine.

Wednesday: Psalm 91

"So what you have in proverbial wisdom and poetic wisdom are general truths, not absolute commands or guarantees. They are practical guides of wisdom. God's normal, providential care is such that we take comfort that we live in the shadow of the Almighty, that we are under the cover of His wings, and all that the psalmist declares in Psalm 91. We don't have to worry about the arrow that flies by day or the scourge that goes by night."

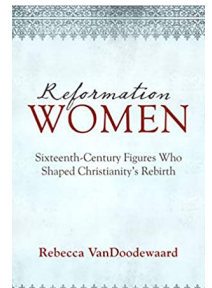
