

Tuesday: Psalm 90

God is the "dwelling place" (v. 1), the home and refuge for His people. This is because God is eternal. "From everlasting to everlasting" (v. 2). speaks to the Lord's eternality. This also serves as a reminder that God never changes. For the believer, our hope is not in something fleeting, but in the Lord, who more solid and secure than we could ever imagine.

Wednesday: Psalm 91

"So what you have in proverbial wisdom and poetic wisdom are general truths, not absolute commands or guarantees. They are practical guides of wisdom. God's normal, providential care is such that we take comfort that we live in the shadow of the Almighty, that we are under the cover of His wings, and all that the psalmist declares in Psalm 91. We don't have to worry about the arrow that flies by day or the scourge that goes by night." - R.C. Sproul




