**Thursday: Psalm 112**

“Particularly noteworthy is Psalm 112:6, which tells us that righteous people will never be moved and that they will be remembered forever. This does not mean righteous men and women never face hardship but that they persevere and are never finally crushed by their trouble.”

**Friday: Psalm 113**

In this short psalm, the word “praise” is used five times. The Lord is to be praise, and He is to be praised throughout the whole world. Focus on your praise of the Lord. Pray that your heart would be filled with praise and adoration for our great God.

**Saturday: Prayer**

Pray over the specific requests from the Standridge family serving in Italy: We are beginning discussions about potential areas to plant a church. We will need lots of wisdom. Please be in prayer for us and for potential church planting partners. Wisdom on best use of time for Jordan. There are lots of ideas and many opportunities with writing, evangelism, preaching etc... **Monday: Psalm 109**

“David knew the pain of abandonment. Yet he can say of the Lord, “He stands at the right hand of the needy one” (Ps. 109:31). The right hand of God is the place of power and honor; it is the place where our Lord Jesus currently stands. But here we are told that God stands next to us, at our right hand, ready to advocate for us!” - Daniel Hyde

**Tuesday: Psalm 110**

This royal psalm deals with the role of David’s house in the life of God’s people. However, this psalm goes beyond the human heir of David and looks forward to the Messiah. As you read through this psalm, consider Jesus and who He is as Savior and Lord.

**Wednesday: Psalm 111**

The works of the Lord are great (v. 2). These are the Lord’s works in creation and those done in redeeming His people. Praise the Lord for His works and His work in your life.

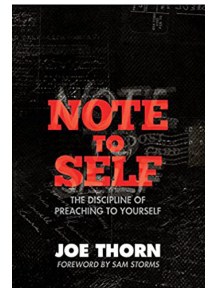
