**Thursday: Psalm 122**

“The fact that the psalm concludes with petitions in verses 6-7 and a commitment to work for the good of Jerusalem in verse 9 suggests that such hopes have yet to be fulfilled. The pilgrim-age to Jerusalem is a reminder or the psalmist and this city, and perhaps the world, remains at unrest – but there is always hope – a hope that is grounded in the presence of the living God.” – The NIV Application Commentary

**Friday: Psalm 123**

Today’s psalm is a community lament where the people are the objects of contempt and scorn. The people are seeking relief from that scorn and praying for God’s mercy. Christians today are no different. When Christians today are the objects of contempt and scorn, they too should pray for God’s mercy and trust in His provision.

**Saturday: Prayer**

Pray for Indian Bible College as they begin the fall semester. Pray that through IBC, the students increase in knowledge of Scripture and that their lives are changed to be more like Christ.

**Monday: Psalm 119**

“Psalm 119 shows us that one of the effects of sin is to make us double-minded. It does this by setting love for God’s law in opposition to double-minded people (v. 113). Thus, we see that the Word of God is single-minded, that is, it does not speak with a forked tongue. The Lord did not talk out of both sides of His mouth rather, He spoke consistently and coherently. We can hope in His Word because it is consistent, because it tells us only the truth about our Creator and how He is a sure refuge for His people (v. 114).” – Ligonier.org

**Tuesday: Psalm 120**

Verses 3-4 address the person who is causing trouble. This person has a “deceitful tongue.” This type of person courts God’s judgment with “sharp arrows” and “glowing coals.” There is a reassurance here that God will deal with those who are deceitful. Pray and ask the Lord to give you a greater trust a reliance on Him knowing that He will deal with the wicked.

**Wednesday: Psalm 121**

“The psalmist says, ‘I lift my eyes up to the hills,’ and then he asks a question: ‘From where does my help come?’ He asks himself this after scanning the world around him and looking for help. Then he remembers the Lord, and he says, as if to himself, ‘My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.’” – Thomas Brewer

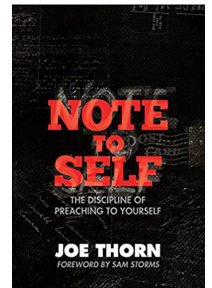
