Thursday: Psalm 127

“Psalm 127:1 states, ‘Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.’ This psalm teaches us that God is the one who is at work to accomplish all of His good purposes and we must not rely on ourselves. Without God’s work, our labors are in vain. We must continue to do the work of building and watching, all the while recognizing that God is the One who will complete the good work He has begun.” -

Friday: Psalm 128

The opening section of today’s psalm provides a picture of how a faithful person sees blessedness. They are the one who fears the Lord and walks in His way (v.1). We also see how this blessedness is connected to labor (v. 2) and family. (v. 3). Being blessed by the Lord is not individualistic but relates to the larger well-being of God’s people.

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for the staff and volunteers of the Community Pregnancy Center. Pray for strength and boldness to serve for Christ and proclaim Him in our community.

Monday: Psalm 124

Today's psalm is a hymn of thanksgiving. The people are thanking the Lord as they had been delivered from a threat. Think about times when the Lord has delivered you from a difficult situation. Consider all the Lord has done for you and pray and praise Him for His faithfulness.

Tuesday: Psalm 125

Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved. This is the secure position that believers have in Christ. This psalm instills confidence in God's people. Pray and ask the Lord to give you greater confidence and trust in the secure position you have in him as a believer.

Wednesday: Psalm 126

"So, here's the lesson: When there are simple, straightforward jobs to be done, and you are full of sadness, and tears are flowing easily, go ahead and do the jobs with tears. Be realistic. Say to your tears, 'Tears, I feel you. You make me want to quit life. But there is a field to be sown (dishes to be washed, car to be fixed, sermon to be written).'" - John Piper on Psalm 126:5-6

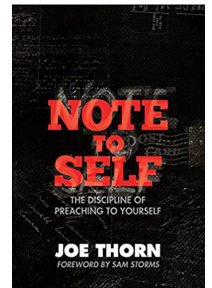
