Thursday: Psalm 132

“Augustine of Hippo comments on today’s passage: ‘Dost thou wish to be a place for the Lord? Be thou poor in spirit, and contrite, and trembling at the word of God, and thou wilt thyself be made what thou seekest.’ In His grace, God calls us to Himself and chooses to dwell within us. We never have to fear that He will leave us, but we make ourselves vessels that are more fit for His presence as we pursue lives of holiness in faith and repentance.” - Ligonier.org

Friday: Psalm 133

Today’s psalm puts forth the ideal situation of a community of true brotherhood: a situation where members of the believing community practice mutual concern for each other. If this were achieved, it would be “good and pleasant,” and it is the church’s goal. This psalm calls for believers to dwell in unity. Pray that believers would seek to prize and dwell in unity.

Saturday: Prayer

Our continued prayer is for the pastors in Nicaragua. Pray for their continued faithfulness and for others to come alongside them to help them in ministry.

Monday: Psalm 129

“When the prophet says twice, ‘They have afflicted me’, ‘they have afflicted me,’ the repetition is not superfluous, it being intended to teach us that the people of God had not merely once or twice to enter the conflict, but that their patience had been tried by continual exercises.” —John Calvin.

Tuesday: Psalm 130

The elements of this psalm are focused on helping worshipers to see themselves as those who are forgiven. They recognize that the only right they have to enter into the presence of God is because of His mercy. So pray and thank the Lord for His mercy, and because of it, you will be in His presence.

Wednesday: Psalm 131

Today’s psalm is one of confidence. The psalm presents a calm and quiet soul—one who trusts and is contented in the Lord as He is the hope in all times.

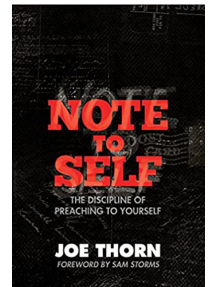
