

"God wants us to pour out our complaints to him and tell him our troubles (Psalm 142:2). He wants us to do it privately, like David did when he wrote Psalm 142 in the cave of Adullam (1 Samuel 22). And he wants us to do it corporately, as when the people of Israel would sing Psalm 142 together. He wants us to tell him exactly what it feels like ('no one cares for my soul,' Psalm 142:4). And he wants us to remember that despite how things look and feel right now, because of his very great promises (2 Peter 1:4), someday these troubles will no longer afflict us ('you will deal bountifully with me,' Psalm 142:7)." — Jon Bloom

## Friday: Psalm 143

"Circumstances breathe down our necks. Stress starts pounding on our doors. We gear up for 17 straight hours of receptivity and productivity. This is where David's prayer in Psalm 143:8 helps. He gets to the heart of the matter. If we are stepping into absorbing and exuding, first things first, let us soak in God's truth and then submit all our doing to his guidance. The best way to start the day, everyday, is with the prayer, in short: let me hear and lead me on." – Jonathan Parnell

## Saturday: Prayer

Pray for the opportunities the Gospel Rescue Mission has to care for those in our community. Pray that those who hear the gospel would confess and repent of their sin and trust in Christ as Savior. Pray for increased opportunities for the Mission to evangelize the lost.

### Monday: Psalm 139

"O LORD, you have searched me and known me!" (v. 1). This verse is the theme of the psalm. The Lord knows everything about us, from what we do and say, to what is in our innermost thoughts. We are not able to fully understand this, yet for the believer, this is a comfort. God knows our innermost sinful thoughts, yet He chooses to love us and is gracious to forgive.

## Tuesday: Psalm 140

Today's psalm is a lament to serve the needs of those under threat from the ungodly, from those who wish to harm. This psalm prays for protection and shows trust in the Lord. Pray for those who are under threat from harm from the ungodly. Pray for protection and greater trust in the Lord.

#### Wednesday: Psalm 141

"Set a guard, O LORD, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips! Do not let my heart incline to any evil, to busy myself with wicked deeds in company with men who work iniquity, and let me not eat of their delicacies!" (v. 3-4). These verses ask the Lord to help avoid the temptation to partake in "iniquity." The prayer is that the Lord would "set a guard," "keep watch," and to "not let my heart incline to any evil."
