Thursday: Psalm 137

“John Calvin comments on Psalm 137:9 that ‘it may seem to savor of cruelty ... but [the psalmist] does not speak under the impulse of personal feeling, and only employs words which God had himself authorized, so that this is but the declaration of a just judgment.’ Sin is so serious that it must be repaid in kind. Thanks be to God, the atonement of Jesus accomplished this for us. Bearing the Lord’s righteous wrath, Christ exhausted the divine curse on our sin and secured blessing for us.” - Ligonier.org

Friday: Psalm 138

Psalm 138 is reminiscent of Psalm 136. There is a call to give thanks to the Lord with the whole heart (v. 1), to give thanks to His name (v.2), and because His steadfast love and faithfulness (v. 2) endures forever (v. 8). Give thanks to the Lord today and every day.

Saturday: Prayer

Pray for the Standridge family serving in Italy. Pray specifically for Jordan as he preaches in churches around Italy. Pray as he preaches Rome at Chiesa Vita Nella Grazia on September 7th and September 14th. Pray for fruit and that hearts would be changed. Continue to pray that they would find the right place to plant a church.

Monday: Psalm 134

Read Psalm 134 below. Read it as a prayer to the Lord. Then, mediate on this Psalm throughout the rest of the day.

“Come, bless the Lord, all you servants of the Lord, who stand by night in the house of the Lord! Lift up your hands to the holy place and bless the Lord! May the Lord bless you from Zion, he who made heaven and earth!”

Tuesday: Psalm 135

We are to praise the Lord. As servants of the Lord, we are to praise His name. Why? Because the Lord is good and the Lord is great, and His name endures forever.

Wednesday: Psalm 136

“For his steadfast love endures forever” occurs 26 times in Psalm 136, once for each verse. One cannot miss the theme presented here. His steadfast love truly endures forever and has throughout history. Give thanks to the Lord “for his steadfast love” that “endures forever.”

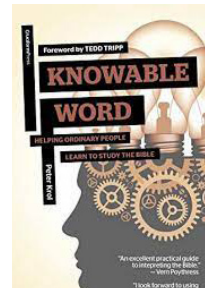
