**Thursday: Psalm 27**

“One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to inquire in his temple” (v. 4). In David’s life, the “one thing” was to live in God’s presence and for His purpose. Pray that you would seek after the Lord, to dwell in the house of the Lord.

**Friday: Psalm 28**

Those who pray in faith rejoice in hope. In this Psalm, David is earnest in prayer. He prays that God would graciously hear him and answer as he calls out to God in distress. David also gives thanks to God as he prays in faith. Pray in faith, trust in God, and rejoice knowing that He hears.

**Saturday: Prayer**

Pray for the Community Pregnancy Center as they seek to promote life and evangelize the lost. Pray for their upcoming *Virtual Walk for Life* event, which aims to bring awareness and helps the Center to remain a valuable resource in our community.

**Monday: Psalm 24**

The Lord is not only the Creator but the Owner of all. He created the land in which we live. He made the plants and animals in which we eat. In these things, we rejoice, praise, and give thanks when we read, “the earth is the LORD’s and the fullness thereof” (v. 1).

**Tuesday: Psalm 25**

Verses 8-11 of today’s passage focuses on praise for the Lord’s goodness and mercy. God is faithful, good, and is steadfast in His love. The psalmist is celebrating God’s character, and we should celebrate also. Pray and praise the Lord for His unchanging character.

**Wednesday: Psalm 26**

This psalm begins with a prayer of vindication. God vindicates the faithful, those who take the covenant to heart, whose life pattern walks in integrity, and trusts in the Lord. The faithful are to walk in His faithfulness.

## Sermon Application

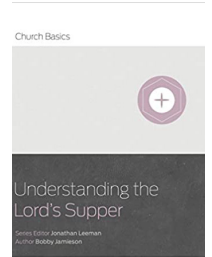
