

40. Why did Christ have to suffer death?

Because God's justice and truth require it: nothing else could pay for our sins except the death of the Son of God.²

41. Why was he "buried"?

His burial testifies that he really died.1

42. Since Christ has died for us, why do we still have to die?

Our death is not a payment for our sins,¹ but only a dying to sins and an entering into eternal life.²

43. What further benefit do we receive from Christ's sacrifice and death on the cross?

By his power our old man is crucified, put to death, and buried with him,¹ so that the evil desires of the flesh may no longer rule us,² but that instead we may offer ourselves as a sacrifice of thanksgiving to him.³

45. How does Christ's resurrection benefit us?

Firstly, by his resurrection he has overcome death, so that he might make us share in the righteousness he obtained for us by his death. Second, by his power we too are already raised to a new life. Third, Christ's resurrection is a sure pledge to us of our blessed resurrection.


