**LORD'S DAY 16 & 17****40. Why did Christ have to suffer death?**

Because God's justice and truth require it:<sup>1</sup> nothing else could pay for our sins except the death of the Son of God.<sup>2</sup>

**41. Why was he "buried"?**

His burial testifies that he really died.<sup>1</sup>

**42. Since Christ has died for us, why do we still have to die?**

Our death is not a payment for our sins,<sup>1</sup> but only a dying to sins and an entering into eternal life.<sup>2</sup>

**43. What further benefit do we receive from Christ's sacrifice and death on the cross?**

By his power our old man is crucified, put to death, and buried with him,<sup>1</sup> so that the evil desires of the flesh may no longer rule us,<sup>2</sup> but that instead we may offer ourselves as a sacrifice of thanksgiving to him.<sup>3</sup>

**45. How does Christ's resurrection benefit us?**

Firstly, by his resurrection he has overcome death, so that he might make us share in the righteousness he obtained for us by his death.<sup>1</sup> Second, by his power we too are already raised to a new life.<sup>2</sup> Third, Christ's resurrection is a sure pledge to us of our blessed resurrection.<sup>3</sup>

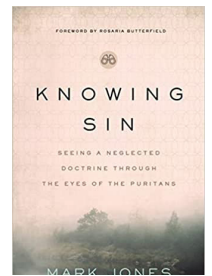
## Book of the Month
