He forbids not only outright theft and robbery, which governing authorities punish,^a but in God's sight theft also includes all evil tricks and schemes designed to get our neighbor's goods for ourselves, whether by force or means that appear legitimate,^b such as inaccurate measurements of weight, size, or volume; fraudulent merchandising; counterfeit money; excessive interest; or any other means forbidden by God.^c

In addition God forbids all greed^d and pointless squandering of his gifts.^e

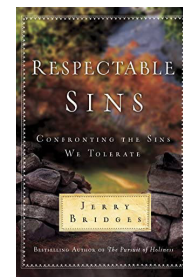
