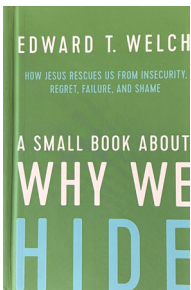

#### ***The Call of the Christian Soldier***

by Megan K. Taylor

*"The early church used soldier imagery to describe the call and conduct of the believer. They used the term **miles Christianus** (soldier of Christ) in contrast to the term **paganus** (heathen or civilian), those who lacked discipline. Paul uses the illustration of a soldier as an example of devotion, courage, and single-mindedness in the face of warfare. When a man enlists, he gives his life away. The most important thing—above family, friends, and work—becomes duty and country. Many times, the cost of such dedication is pain, suffering, or their very life. Likewise, the life of a Christian should not resemble the life of a private citizen. It ought to reflect the call and discipline of a soldier who is willing to sacrifice their life to please their captain."*
