Next Week: Exodus 15:22-17:7

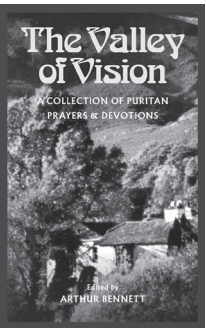

The Valley of Vision by Arthur Bennett
