



## Health Policies

**Along with your child's growth in the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, their health and safety is our top priority. As a staff team, we are continually researching, discussing, and praying about the best practices and measures which will provide the greatest protection for your child. With research developing daily, we will communicate any updates that are made to our health policies. If your child or a family member has experienced any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours or has recently come in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19, please stay home.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Questionable Rash
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Drainage from the Eye(s)

### Entering Capital Kids:

- Upon entering the Capital Kids area, your child's temperature will be taken using a touchless body thermometer. If a child's temperature is above 100.4, we cannot admit the child to Capital Kids and the family will be politely asked to return the child to their home.
- We will provide a touchless check in process for all families.
- Parents can walk their child to their classroom but cannot enter the classroom.

### In the Classroom:

- Teachers will be required to wear masks at all times in the classroom.
- Students will not be required to wear masks.
- When children enter the classroom, they will immediately be asked to wash their hands.
- Toys and classroom materials will be cleaned before and after use on Sundays.
- Personal items will not be allowed to stay with the child each Sunday. Instead, we ask that you pack one Ziplock bag with any "emergency" items, such as an extra set of clothes. This bag will remain at the church until they are used or until the end of the year. Diapers, wipes and snacks will be provided. If your child needs their own diapers, wipes, or snacks because of an allergy or medical condition, please contact Jamie Bentley.
- In the classroom, children will be spaced out during lessons and planned activities. They will be allowed to come within six feet of another child during play.
- Snacks will be provided. Children will receive hand sanitizer and will eat while spaced adequately apart from other children. Snacks will be distributed by teachers wearing gloves and masks.

If someone in your child's class does test positive for COVID-19, we will communicate to all affected families immediately. We will do so while also maintaining the privacy of each child.
