*Psalm 119*

*I. Recognize the Authority of God's Word for Blessing (Ps 119:1-8)*

*A. It is the word of the Master: the law giver (v.1)*

*B. The word became text to guide and bless us (v.1-8; Jn 1:1)*

*II. Recognize the Power of God's Word for Blessing (Ps 119:41-45)*

*A. It is the Word that heals and transforms (v.9-11; Rom 1:16)*

*B. The word became flesh to personally save us (John 1:10-12)*

*III. Recognize the Need of Discovery of God's Word for Blessing (Ps 119:17-24)*

*A. It is the word that brings understanding and intimacy with God (v.33-40)*

*B. The word became text and flesh, and we are blessed by His grace, truth, and glory (Jn 1:14-18)*

*IV. Recognize our Responsibility to Apply God's Word for Blessing (Ps 119:57-64)*

*A. We must have discipline to apply the word (v.145-149; II Pet 1:3-8)*

*B. Obedience to the word is a matter of personal choice: remember Naaman (v.59-60; II Kings 5)*

*Thoughts for application:*

*1. Do you feel that you hold the word of God in high regard? How is that reflected in your daily life?*

*2. How do you experience the power of God's word for blessing in your daily life? When was the last time you applied God's word to a situation and were blessed by doing it?*

*3. What are you doing to pursue a deeper relationship with God through His word? When you read, study, or hear God's word taught, what do you do with what you have learned to draw you closer to Him?*

*4. How do you seek to apply God's word to your everyday life? Write down one example of how you applied God's word this past week?*
