Titus - Part 10 | Titus 3:8-15 | week of November 12

**GETTING STARTED**

- What topics are most frequently discussed around your dinner table? Around the water cooler in your office?

**Read Titus 3:8-15.**

**DISCUSS & APPLY**

- According to Paul, what should Titus stress to his church (v. 8)?
- What should Titus avoid (v. 9)?
- Why do we often find ourselves focusing on disagreements and quarrels, rather than the gospel?
- Do you find it easy to discuss controversy instead of the gospel? When? How, practically, can we “stress these things” - that is, the content of the gospel - in our conversations and lives?

- Why does Paul use such strong language in verses 10-11? What is at stake when it comes to the unity of the church?
- How seriously do you view divisiveness?
- What are some small, subtle habits that stand in the way of unity in the church? Which of these do you need to repent of?
- The main theme in Titus is the relationship between gospel doctrine and good works (see 2:1, 10; 3:8, 14; etc.). Evaluate yourself in relation to good works. What is one new, specific way you can live for the benefit of others?

- Who do you know that needs you to remind them of God's kindness in the gospel today? How will you do that?
