## Basic Supplies:

- 1 Binder with dividers or a notebook for note taking in each class.
- Loose-leaf paper
- Pencils/Pens (black or blue)
- Highlighters
- Clorox/Lysol wipes
- Hand Sanitizer
- Tissues
- No. 2 pencils
- Pencil erasers

## English:

- 1 ½- inch 3- ring binder with clear plastic cover
- 5-tab multi-colored dividers for notebook
- Merriam-Webster New World Dictionary and Thesaurus (combined)
- White-ruled 3x5 index cards (1 package)
- White-ruled 4x6 index cards (1 package)
- Heavy-duty page protectors (1 pack)
- Notebook paper
- Plastic folder with pockets and prongs
- Spiral notebook (100 sheets or less) with 3 holes to put in binder for journal

Recommendation: Buy enough notebook paper, pens and pencils to last a minimum of one quarter. Plan to replenish your student's supplies at the end of each quarter. Students many times do not remember to tell their parents when they run out of supplies, and they start coming to class unprepared, which negatively impacts their grade.
