Heidelberg Catechism Questions 33-34

Q. 33: Why is He called God's only begotten Son, since we also are

children of God?

Answer: Because Christ alone is the eternal, natural Son of God.

We, however, are children of God by adoption, through

grace, for Christ's sake.

Q. 34: Why do you call Him our Lord?

"Herein, indeed, is a humbling truth, yet a fact it is that Christians are, in themselves, incapable of discharging their duty. Though the love of God has been shed abroad in their hearts and a principle of holiness (or new nature) communicated to them, yet they are unable to perform the good they ardently desire to do...Thus it is imperative that they daily seek from God fresh supplies of grace." (A.W. Pink)

Answer:

Because He has ransomed us, body and soul, from all our sins, not with silver or gold but with His precious blood, and has freed us from all the power of the devil to make us His own possession.






