For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is

in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

Q. 58: What is required in the fourth commandment?

Answer: The fourth commandment requires the keeping holy to God such set times as He has appointed in His Word; expressly one whole day in seven, to be a holy Sabbath to

Himself.



### **NURSERY CARE**


