Corporate Confession of Sin

Lord, we thank You that You are a God who does not wink at iniquity and sin, but that You judge sin for what it is: rebellion against You. When we think of sin, we cannot think of sin in the abstract. We cannot only think of others' sin, but we must think of our own sin, how we have rebelled against You. We think of how we have broken covenant with You, and of how many times we, who have named the name of Jesus Christ and profess to be Your children, have doubted Your grace and peace. For this we ask Your forgiveness. We ask that You would forgive us for doubting that You are not only our God, but that You are our great, loving, covenant God. We ask this in the name of our Savior, Jesus Christ.


