Sermon Text John 5:31-38

<sup>31</sup> If I alone bear witness about Myself, My testimony is not true. <sup>32</sup> There is another who bears witness about Me, and I know that the testimony that He bears about Me is true. <sup>33</sup> You sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth. <sup>34</sup> Not that the testimony that I receive is from man, but I say these things so that you may be saved. <sup>35</sup> He was a burning and shining lamp, and you were willing to rejoice for a while in his light. <sup>36</sup> But the testimony that I have is greater than that of John. For the works that the Father has given Me to accomplish, the very works that I am doing, bear witness about Me that the Father has sent me. <sup>37</sup> And the Father who sent Me has Himself borne witness about Me. His voice you have never heard, His form you have never seen, <sup>38</sup> and you do not have His word abiding in you, for you do not believe the one whom He has sent.
