

REVIEW: HUMILIATION KEYTEXT

• 6 who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but made himself nothing, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. (Phil. 2:6–8)

THE ESTATE OF EXALTATION

KEYTEXT

• Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:9-11)

HUMBLED TO BE EXALTED

HUMILIATION

- Remember the key text? Paul tells us that Jesus voluntarily humbled Himself
- Phil. 2:6-8

EXALTATION

- By humbling Himself, Jesus fulfilled the covenant. For this God the Father highly exalted Him
- Phil 2:9-10

WHY WAS JESUS EXALTED?




- Jesus was exalted because He:
 - Fulfilled the covenant
 - God wanted us to KNOW that if was FINISHED!
- ROMANS I:1-4

WHAT IS EXALTATION?

- Rising again from the dead
- Ascension
- Seated at the Right Hand of the Father
- Coming Again to Judge the World

RISING AGAIN FROM THE DEAD

- Death could not hold Him or corrupt Him
- He rose from the dead by
 His own power
- He was declared to be the Son of God, Who defeated death and is Lord



ASCENSION



- Jesus' ascension shows
 His victory over our
 enemies
- He is preparing a place for His people!

SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND

- Jesus is seated at God the Father's right hand
 - A place of power and authority
 - He is king ruling
 - He is priest—interceding
 - He is prophet keeping His Word
