Review: Why is it so hard?

Review: Proving Personality

- Spirit has Personal Properties (Will, Wisdom, Power)
- Spirit has Works
- Seen in sign of baptism of Christ
- Seen in the covenant

Review: Spirit is God

He is Called God He has Divine Attributes

- Eternity (Hebrews 9:14)
- Immensity (Psalm 139:7)
- Omnipotence (Micah 2:7)
- Omniscience (1 Cor. 2:10-11; Acts 1:16)

God is Triune

What does that mean?

 All the actions of God are the actions of <u>each</u> Person of the Trinity

Why is that the case?

The Trinity cannot be divided

What is the consequence?

 Since the Spirit is a Person of the Trinity, He is involved with all God's works.

The Work of Creation

Father

 And when they heard it, they lifted their voices together to God and said, "Sovereign Lord, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and everything in them" (Acts 4:24)

Son

 All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. (John 1:3)

Holy Spirit

The Spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life.
 (Job 33:4)

Concluding Work of Spirit

Within Trinity, the concluding, completing, perfecting acts are ascribed to Him

- Most hidden and Mysterious acts
- Without Him no work of God is <u>complete</u>
- Generally speaking:
 - The Father originates (Rom. 11:36)
 - The Son establishes and upholds (Col. 1:17; Heb 1:3)
 - The Spirit finishes and perfects

 By his wind the heavens were made fair; his hand pierced the fleeing serpent. (Job 26:13)

Earth and Creatures

- The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. (Genesis 1:2)
- When you hide your face, they are dismayed; when you take away their breath, they die and return to their dust.
 When you send forth your Spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the ground.
 (Psalm 104:29-30)

Man

- Life giving principle that was added to the dust was the breath of life (Genesis 2:7)
- Christ in the work of the new creation breathed on His disciples (John 20:22)
- The restoration of the image of God is the work of the Spirit: Mind, Will, Disposition to obey God

Authority

No one can give but His own

Freedom

- We contribute nothing
 - For who sees anything different in you? What do you have that you did not receive? If then you received it, why do you boast as if you did not receive it? (1 Corinthians 4:7)
- It is a privilege and advantage
 - Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus is accursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the Holy Spirit. (1 Corinthians 12:3)
 - To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. (1 Corinthians 12:7)

Given by God

Bounty

- The importance is not the gifts but the graces (Matthew 7:22-23)
- On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.' (Matthew 7:22–23)
- whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, (Titus 3:6)

Sent by God

Accomplished

- Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing. (Acts 2:33)
- And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying,
 "Abba! Father!" (Galatians 4:6)

Refers to His special work, not location

- Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there! (Psalm 139:7–8)
- even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you. (John 14:17)

Ministered, Put Upon, Poured Out

Supply, Minister to, Add to

- Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith— (Galatians 3:5)
- for I know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance, (Philippians 1:19)

Put On, Place, Establish

- Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my Spirit upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations. (Isaiah 42:1)
- And I will **put my Spirit within you**, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I am the Lord; I have spoken, and I will do it, declares the Lord." (Ezekiel 37:14)
- "Behold, my servant whom I have chosen, my beloved with whom my soul is well pleased. I will put my Spirit upon him, and he will proclaim justice to the Gentiles. (Matthew 12:18)

Ministered, Put Upon, Poured Out

Poured Out

- he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, (Titus 3:5-6)
- For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will **pour my Spirit upon** your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants. They shall spring up among the grass like willows by flowing streams. (Isaiah 44:3–4)
