This team is working together with Hood Construction and Catalyst Architects in putting together a short range and long range plan for the renovations of the property.

God has blessed our church in providing two godly men to lead us forward. Wayne Rogers of Catalyst Architects has agreed to do his work on the project as a gift to the church. He is a follower of Jesus Christ, and is very engaged in the work of God's kingdom. He is excited about the replanting of Christ Covenant Church at Covenant Road. He will be working together with our team and Dean Wilson of Hood Construction to put together renderings both for the short and long term plans for the property. Dean Wilson has worked together with a number of churches in the Columbia area, not only doing excellent work in his profession, but also as a follower of Jesus Christ investing in our Lord's kingdom. He will be leading us forward in this effort, not to make great profits for Hood Construction, but to see God's kingdom advancing through his church. We are thankful for how the Lord has lead us to these individuals and their professional organizations.

We will be meeting together next week with Wayne Rogers and Dean Wilson to review the Phase I renderings and the Master Plan Diagram. Phase I for Covenant Road is necessary for Christ Covenant Church to begin Worshiping Together and have Life Together on Sunday mornings. Phase I will focus on Worship, Nursery, and Bathroom / Office Space. You will soon have an opportunity to see and hear more details regarding these plans. The budget we are setting for these projects is \$250,000. We will be trusting the Lord together to provide for our needs as we move forward in the first quarter of 2019.
