Childcare & Sunday School | There is nursery for infants, toddlers, and 2-year-olds in the back hall of the church. Mask Wearing | We are encouraged by the decreasing COVID hospitalizations and ICU numbers in the Region since May 23rd. As you know, masks are not currently required at CCRC. However, encouragement is given to everyone who wants to wear a mask. There are members in our church who feel more comfortable attending around others who wear masks due to existing health concerns and compromised immune systems.
