Faith Mukumbo Liyena a young Christian nurse was touched by the despair of the children and made it her first priority to offer hope to these children. After careful planning, the Faith Orphanage Foundation was born in 1992 and registered in 1993 as a Non-Governmental Christian Charitable Organisation.
