Ephesians 2:11-22

Remember Our Need for Reconciliation (vv. 11-12)

- A relational problem: separation from the people of God. (vv. 11-12a)
- A religious problem: separation from the blessing of God. (v. 12b)

Realize the Provision of Reconciliation (vv. 13-22)

- God has brought sinners near through the blood of Christ. (vv. 13)
- Jesus has made in himself one new man out of two. (vv. 14-16)
- So that...
 - We have a common heritage. (v. 17)
 - We have a common privilege. (v. 18)
 - We have a common King. (v. 19)
 - We have a common Father. (v. 19)
 - We have a common purpose. (vv. 20-22)

Respond to the Reality of Reconciliation

- Preach peace, to those both near and far.
- Welcome one another in the body of Christ.
- Embrace diversity as a display of God’s glory.
