This photo scavenger hunt will walk you and your family through the events of Holy week. Each number will have a Bible reading, a short explanation, and a picture challenge!

1. **Palm Sunday:** Read Matthew 21: 8–11. Holy Week starts with Palm Sunday. On Palm Sunday Jesus entered the city of Jerusalem riding on a Donkey. A Large crowd of people laid down jackets and palm fronds on the ground for the Donkey to walk on. This is what people would do when anyone royal would come to town.

2. **Maundy Thursday:** Read Matthew 26:26–29. Maundy Thursday (Holy Thursday) is the night before Jesus died. Jesus and His disciples were celebrating Passover together. This was the last meal that Jesus had with the disciples, and is where Jesus started the practice of communion. Jesus also washed the disciples feet this night and taught them to put other people before themselves.

3. **Jesus Prays in Gethsemane:** Mark 14:32–36. After Celebrating Passover with His disciples, they all went to a garden to pray. Jesus prays to the Father, asking for His will to be done. Soon after, one of Jesus' disciples, Judas, betrays Jesus. Judas gave Jesus over to the Jewish leaders to be crucified.

4. **Good Friday:** Read Mark 15:24–26. The Friday of Holy Week is called "Good Friday." It is the day that Jesus was killed on a cross. Jesus lived a perfect life, and died on a cross in our place. Because Jesus did this, we have life forever with God from this moment on! Jesus' death paid the price for our sin so that WE can have a relationship with God!

5. **The Resurrection:** Read Mark 16:5–7. Jesus was buried for three days, but when some of His followers went to the tomb, they found that the stone in front of the tomb had been rolled away! Mary Magdalene at first thought that someone had stolen Jesus' body, but then Jesus appeared to her and then to the disciples! Jesus' defeated death for us!
