

## Go on Your Way



**Background** – This series is designed to show us the sovereignty of God and that He controls all things, no matter what our circumstances might say.

**Key Verse/Scripture Memory** – [Daniel 12:13](#)

**Core Passage** - [Daniel 12](#)

**Take Away** - Go on Your way (keep walking) and rest because God is in control.

### Sermon Guide:

#### I. How do I keep going and walking with God when there seems to be no end in sight of suffering?

- 1) Read and trust in the promises of God.  
[Daniel 12:5-7, Hebrews 12:2-3](#)
- 2) Embrace your brokenness and receive God's strength.  
[Daniel 12:7, 2 Corinthians 12:7-10](#)
- 3) Be empowered by the Holy Spirit and walk by faith.  
[Daniel 12:8-12, Ephesians 5:18-20](#)
- 4) Joyfully equip people to know Jesus and follow Him.  
[Daniel 12:13, Colossians 1:9-13](#)

#### II. How can we apply God's Word to our lives?

- 1) Surrender and depend upon Jesus for everything.
- 2) Make a commitment and repeat after me....

#### III. Family/Small Group Discussion

- 1) Pray – That the message of Daniel would encourage us to trust God for our future.
- 2) Briefly review the sermon outline. Have people read aloud a few of the scriptures covered and explain why they are important and meaningful.
- 3) Discuss together:
  1. Did you ever read a book whose ending you already knew? How did you read that book differently than other books that you were not familiar with?

2. Review [Daniel 12:1-3](#). Because God will raise those who believe from the dead and give them eternal life, what should our response be right now in this life? How can we be sure that our resurrection is a reality?
3. How might Daniel's remarks in 12:8 that he "heard but did not understand" encourage you as you try to understand both the Bible and what God wants of you?
4. A major theme throughout Daniel is that God is sovereign over earthly rulers and that He will reign forever. How much do you long for His eternal reign? What could help to increase your desire to see God reign?
5. Review the Book of Daniel:
  - a) What does the Book of Daniel teach us about God? About humankind?
  - b) Throughout this series, what has God revealed in your life that needs changing?
  - c) What truth can be applied to your life about the gospel?
