We **GATHER** and worship together on Sunday mornings as **one church family.** This is the environment where we **give generously of our time, treasure, and talent.** We study scripture, learn to praise God, celebrate communion, and pray for the personal encouragement and courage to live a completely surrendered life in Jesus Christ.

Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching. - Hebrews 10:23-25
