There will be special Easter Bags available in the sanctuary for children ages 5-12 which will include activities for both younger and older ages. CHILDREN'S MINSITRY

We are seeking volunteers to help with the Easter Event. The games will be as follows:

Kids crafts Basket – items for coloring, paints, bubbles, chalk, candy, stickers, play-doh

Toddler Play Basket – board books, snuggle toy, bubbles, ball, apple sauce pouches, building blocks, easy puzzle, the Jesus Storybook Bible

There is also a list of donation items needed for the event in the lobby of both buildings and also a collection basket. The youth have volunteered to stuff the eggs for the egg hunt. If you have already signed up to help, we thank you.

MISSION PROJECT

LITTLE DRESSES FOR AFRICA.ORG (WEBSITE)

Hello everyone, my name is Dawn Snyder. A few weeks ago, my husband brought me this article about a woman named Rachel who started this Christian non-profit group called little dresses for Africa. She started her mission wanting to make these dresses to help the African girls improve their self-esteem and making a better life for them hoping that this would make a difference in their lives to be better people in their country. Right now, they are working in the country of Malawi in Africa. They also raise money to help them get clean drinking water and better medical care. You can go to their website and learn a lot more about what they are doing over there.

Since I am a sewing person, I was very interested as to what I could do in my little corner of the world to help these girls who probably don't even own a dress. With God's help, I would like to send a box of dresses to this organization sometime this summer. I thought since we do have sewers at our church maybe other might like to get involved too.

These dresses are very simple to make and don't involve a lot of time or money. These dresses basically just slide over the girl's heads. No zippers or buttons are requested. You can go to the website and print patterns they have there, or I have copies of these patterns to give out. They can be sundresses with ribbons that tie around their shoulder, T-shirt dresses which require you to buy a T-shirt(no logos but maybe like a heart on it) and just put a ruffle at the bottom of the shirt. Also, you can make a pillowcase dress and I have the pattern for that as well. They need sizes 2-14. They also would like bright colors for the dresses. I am getting my grandchildren involved as well showing them how to give back to the world. If you are a really good sewer, I will have a few Simplicity patterns that can make these dresses too.

For those of you who do not like to sew, you could purchase a dress and donate it. You could go to consignment stores or Community Aid and purchase very inexpensive dresses but remember they must just be able to slip over their heads.

If you have any questions, please contact me by phone (717-292-4729) or by email(dlsnyder@ddogcom.net) and please contact me if you will be making or donating any dresses to this cause. I would like to send these dresses sometime in June or July. The organization does ask for every dress you make, you donate 2 dollars to help in shipping costs to Africa. Thank you all for your consideration in helping these girls have a better life.
