Where: Meeting at church in the Education Wing

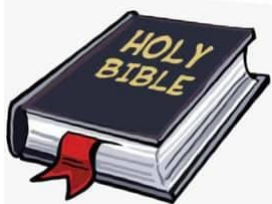
This month the tweens will have a fun evening playing board games and creating Valentine's Cards for residents of a local nursing home.
