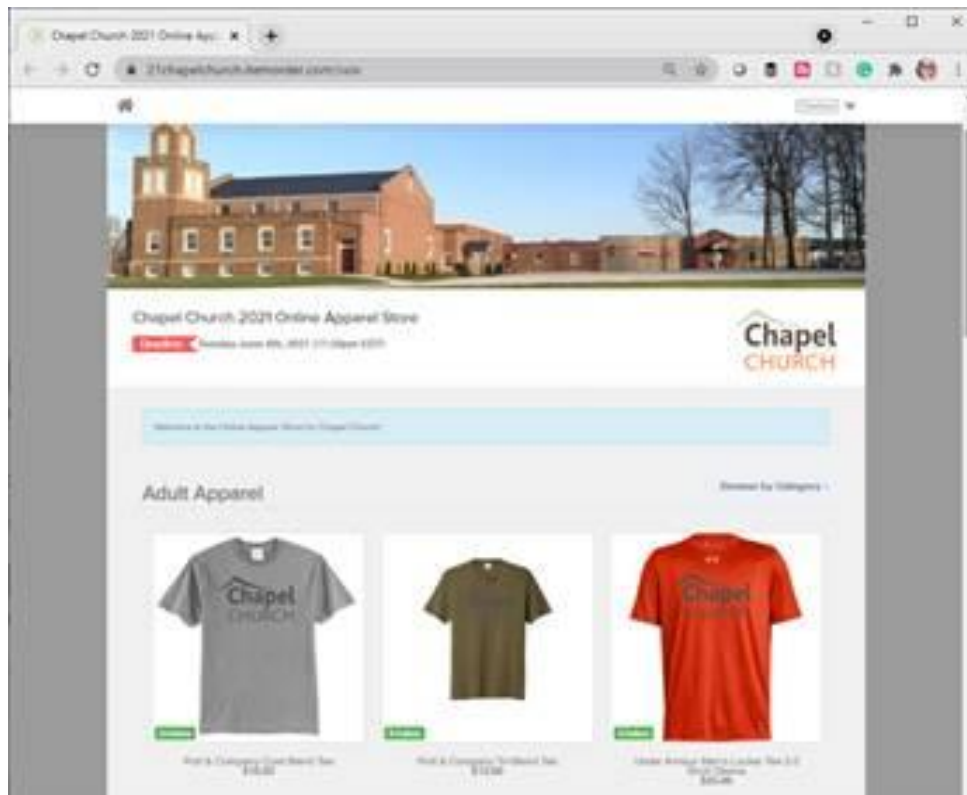
YARD SALE

Praise God! He continues to bless Chapel Church in so many ways. Thanks to some very generous bequests over the past two years, Phase II of the HVAC installation has been completed without the need for a capital fundraising project! This Phase II installation covered nearly all of the 1983 addition to the building, except the fellowship hall, narthex and lounge, which were included as part of Phase I.

The only remaining sections of the building that are heated/cooled by the old system(s) is the basement and sanctuary. Future plans are to replace these components as part of Phase III (timing and cost not yet known).

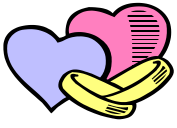
