Homeless Backpacks Distributed:

Today Pastor Josh and I finally got a chance to deliver the homeless backpacks that have been sitting in the sanctuary since Spring to several law enforcement agencies in the area. These packs were stuffed with a tarp, sleeping bag, gloves, winter hat, hand warmers, wash clothes, towel, toilet paper, many personal care items and a bible. We delivered 2 packs each to the following agencies in our area:

- York Area Regional Police
- Spring Garden Township Police
- York City Police
- Springettsbury Township Police

Additionally, we will be providing a pack to a homeless gentleman, who has been seen in the square in Red Lion recently, with one these backpacks as well. We also stopped by York's Helping Hand for the Homeless in York and dropped off a donation of extra supplies we had collected during the project to include smaller backpacks, wash clothes, towels, sleeping bags and additional supplies.

Again, thank you to everyone who supported this mission project. These were well received and we made some great connections to help provide support to the homeless in the future.
