October Prayer Focus - Back to the Bible

Greeting Friends as we look to this fall season of returning to school schedules, daily routines from a lazy (or hectic with activities) summer with your family ... to a Prayer Focus that has all the potential for a refreshing and enlightened outlook.... Back to the Bible. Please read this excerpt from "Where Do We Go From Here", Dr. David Jeremiah:

The average American household owns between three and ten Bibles, but forty-two percent of American Christians are too busy to read them. As Christians, we need to understand the reality of biblical illiteracy, first in our own lives and families but also in the church. That's spiritual famine! People who disregard the Bible may someday get what they want--a society where the Bible is no longer read or proclaimed and where they can freely sin without Scripture confronting their conscience. A society without the moral compass of Scripture will self-destruct from moral decay and decadence. We can't do much to alleviate the spiritual famine around us until we have a similar concern within us. We need the compelling love of Christ burning like a fire in our hearts for a famished globe. We need a fresh vision for the world.

Won't you join us in our Prayer Focus of Back to the Bible? Stay tuned for more on this topic from Pastor Josh as his messages will fill us with hunger for the Bread of Life and Water to satisfy a thirst that the world cannot offer.
