PRAISE Personal Bible Study

P: Pray!

engagement and opening ourselves up to
God

checking our stuff at the door



PRAISE Personal Bible Study

R: Read the Text

find a plan that keeps you reading in
context

read to yourself and out loud



PRAISE Personal Bible Study

A: Ask Questions

keep questions moving toward personal application

APPLY ANYTHING THAT 'POPS'



PRAISE Personal Bible Study

I: Interpret in Context

answering, pondering, and/or researching
your questions



PRAISE Personal Bible Study

S: Specific (Measurable) Application

making application to yourself, a situation,
or the world around you

more specific (and measurable if possible)
the better



PRAISE Personal Bible Study

E: Engage with God (Pray!)

1. Your application
2. The Lord's Prayer as an outline:
 - God's Honor
 - God's Kingdom
 - God's Provision
 - God's Forgiveness
 - God's Power



PRAISE Personal Bible Study

Pray

Read the Text in Context

Ask Questions (or Apply if it Pops)

Interpret in Context

Specific (Measurable) Application

Engage the Lord in Prayer



Prayer for 2 Services

1. Two services: connecting more people God and each other
2. Praise for new volunteers & a couple more for Chatham Kids, set-up, and hospitality
3. God to use invitations (ours, the flyer) to draw people to himself
4. Wisdom: last-minute details & next 6 weeks evaluation
