



FAMILY WORSHIP GUIDE

Jesus says in **Luke 24** that the entire Bible points to Him and what He came to do. Through readings from Scripture and the Jesus Storybook Bible (JSB), we want to help you help your kids learn to see Jesus in all of Scripture.

We understand that everything in this guide isn't age appropriate for every child. Let this guide be a tool, choose what works best for your family.

Story Time:

Read the Bible: Read **Matthew 4** (The New International Reader's Version (NIRV) is great for kids just learning to read.)

Read/Watch the JSB story: Let's Go! (page 208, [video](#))

Story Related Activity:

Print the [activity page](#).

Ask your child/children to draw a picture of the story on the activity page.

If your child/children is able, ask them to copy the Bible verse—**Matthew 4:19**—on the lines below their picture.



Talk About the Story (Older Kids):

Remember when Adam and Eve met the snake? How was this meeting different than that one? (Look back to pages 28-35)

Remember when God's people were tired and hungry in the wilderness? How did Jesus react differently than they did? (Look back to pages 100-107, esp. 102-103)

What was the most important rule of all? (see page 105)

Do you think Jesus remembered this rule? How do you know?

Who do you think would make the best helpers?

Why did Jesus choose the people He did?

Pray About the Story:

Pray aloud, asking God to help you and your child/children to be disciples of Jesus.

Thank Him that He will help you follow, learn from, obey, and tell others about Jesus.

Ask your child/children to think of one way they can follow Jesus this week and to pray that God would help them to do it.
