

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

THE PRAYER OF INVOCATION

Taken with permission from Christ Church Presbyterian, Evans, GA.

With the Call to Worship, a Biblical dialogue between God and His people begins and continues throughout the service of worship. The Prayer of Invocation is whereby God's people respond to His call by imploring Him to assist us as we worship. In this way we acknowledge our inability to offer acceptable worship in our own strength, and claim the promise that by His Spirit where two or three are gathered together Christ will be present also (Matthew 18:20).

While the exact contents of the Invocation have varied through the centuries, The Westminster "Directory for the Public Worship of God" (1644) still stands us in good stead as a benchmark:

"The congregation being assembled; the Minister, after solemn calling on them to the worshipping of the great name of God, is to begin with Prayer; In all reverence and Humility acknowledging the incomprehensible Greatness and Majesty of the Lord, (in whose presence they do then in a special manner appear) and their own vileness and unworthiness to approach so near him; with their utter inability of themselves, to so great a Work: And humbly beseeching him for Pardon, Assistance, and Acceptance in the whole Service then to be performed; and for a Blessing on that particular portion of his Word then to be read: and all, in the Name and Mediation of the Lord Jesus Christ."

But we should keep in mind that the pastor or elder who prays isn't someone we hire to do our praying for us! It is our responsibility to pray with him as he leads us, and to fervently add our "amen" to his prayers throughout the service.

21 DAYS OF PERSONAL WORSHIP CHALLENGE

Unless we are intentional to abide with Christ regularly, we can easily grow cold and loveless for Him and His Church. Many of us may be in the habit of **NOT** spending committed time in Bible study and prayer. Psychologists have said it can take 21 days to **BREAK** a bad habit! Let's spur one another on to return to our first love and to increase in love for Jesus and His church. *Thanks to Perimeter PCA Church for this excellent challenge and tool to spur on God's people to growing in love for Jesus and His Church!*

Please view the following challenge as a fun game with one another and a tool to break bad habits, begin good habits and to develop a deeper relationship with Jesus.

Here are the rules . . . *(Please do not let the "rules" oppress you. This is NOT to be discouraging, but a fun way for a church to spur one another on to more intentional time with Jesus)*

1. **The goal:** 21 days in a row of personal worship
2. **The 'day off':** You can set one day in seven as a "mulligan", meaning missing that designated day (same day each week), will not count against your 21 one day in a row pursuit.
3. **Back to DAY ONE:** If you skip any other day than you "mulligan", you start back over at 0.

For you who find yourself discouraged about moving back to day one, take heart!

You are spending time with Jesus!

If the rules of this challenge get in the way of you and Jesus, then DROP the rules!

RECOMMENDED MODEL FOR EACH DAY:

Some of us have plans and strategies for how to approach time with Jesus. Here is a helpful model that incorporates a number of healthy elements important in our growth process.

1. First, pray, asking God to forgive specific sins and to speak to you from this passage.
2. Read the Biblical text carefully, noting your observations about the passage.
3. Ask questions to help you interpret and apply the text to your personal life.
4. Interpret the passage in a way that is consistent with the teaching of all Scripture.
5. Summarize a specific and measurable application of the text to your personal life. By God's grace I will . . .
6. Engage with God in prayer using the five targets of the Lord's Prayer: It can be helpful to pray through the Psalms to help you think of various aspects of who God is instead of trying to think them all up from scratch.

God's Honor - acknowledging His worth, glory, and majesty
"Our Father in heaven, hallowed is your name."

God's Kingdom - acknowledging His priority in the world and in your life
"Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

God's Provision - acknowledging His trustworthiness
"Give us this day our daily bread,"

God's Forgiveness - acknowledging your repentance
"And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors."

God's Power - acknowledging your dependence
"And deliver us from the evil one so that we may not be led into temptation."

Accept the challenge TODAY with your church family to this 21 DAYS OF PERSONAL WORSHIP.

QUESTIONS FOR FAMILIES & COMMUNITY GROUPS LETTERS FROM JESUS "AVOIDING THE LOVELESS VERDICT" Revelation 2:1-7

1. The decrease in love is related both to their relationship to Jesus and to one another. How does the first impact the latter?
2. How might our own church culture be in danger of falling away from our first love like Ephesus had?
3. What are warning signs that we have lost our first love? Discuss some of those issues addressed in the sermon (i.e. truth with no grace and love, knowledge without relationship, comfort at the sake of mission, contempt over compassion, lack of personal repentance, trusting in own works and performance instead of in Jesus' performance)
4. How might we be intentional to "remember" the love we had at first?
5. What might hinder us from repenting in this area of relationship to Jesus and His gospel?
