We have a new website that is up but still under construction. Please check it out at **www.christcommunitycobb.org**. Josh has worked hard on it to get it up and running.



Key Truth: The Holy Spirit empowers us to live by faith in all that our good Father has done and will bring to completion for us in Christ.

Introduction:

Q: What sustains your hope when you become especially aware of your weaknesses?

Romans 8:26-30: The Intercession of the Holy Spirit: Faith in God's Good Purpose

"Basic to all Christian thought and all Christian living are: 1) An understanding of how the present sufferings of Christians and the present situation of God's creation relate to the destined glory of believers in Jesus. 2) A vital conviction regarding the hope given by God to all believers in Jesus. 3) A lively realization of the Spirit's help and intercession before God on behalf of those who are God's people. 4) The assurance of Christians that God 'works all things together' for good to those who love Him and are called according to His purpose. Everything else in the thought and life of a Christian is dependent on the consciousness and experience of these primary truths."
