**Key Truth:** God's signs help us live out our transformation in Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit.

**Introduction:**

**Q:** *How does your baptism continue to help you live humbly in union with Christ?*

**Romans 2:25-29: The Signs of God's Love: Means of Grace for the Authentic Life in Christ**

"Because the Spirit is at work in (the saved), what (the saved one) does with its body becomes an authentic expression of worship, not merely one of pretense. This Jew who is one inwardly and is circumcised by the Spirit, has God's praise: this is to be the only concern of the genuine Jew and this alone is what Christianity is to pursue. Thus all play acting has been separated from its life, which is merely intended to dazzle the eyes of spectators and to elicit their praise.....In the name of Jesus (Paul) offered them that which is truly good, the true praise and authentic life."
