MISSIONAL SERVING OPPORTUNITY



CHILDREN'S MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR NEW MINISTRY YEAR



Key Truth: God's salvation is in Christ alone by faith alone through His grace alone.

Introduction:

Q: How do you typically view things that are free? What impact does it have on the value that you place on it if it is free?

Romans 9:27-33: God's Free Grace and the Cost of Demanding to Pay:

“But how they stumble at Christ, who trust in their works, it is not difficult to understand; for except we own ourselves to be sinners, void and destitute of any righteousness of our own, we obscure the dignity of Christ, which consists in this, that to us all he is light, life, resurrection, righteousness and healing. But how is all these things, except that he illuminates the blind, restores the lost, quickens the dead, raises up those who are reduced to nothing, cleanses those who are full of filth, cures and heals those infected with diseases? Nay, when we claim for ourselves any righteousness we in a manner contend with the power of Christ; for his office is no less to beat down all the pride of the flesh, than to relieve and comfort those who labour and are wearied under their burden.”
