Key Truth: Lord's Day Sabbath worship offers us the blessing of God's presence which draws us to worship and sustains us the rest of the week.

Introduction:

Q: What helps you most during difficult days?

Psalm 84: A Divine Invitation to Be Blessed by God's Presence:
