Matthew 12:46-50: Mothers and Brothers and Sisters of Jesus

"The way for us to be as close to Jesus as His nearest and dearest is to do the will of His Father...[Note carefully that] we do not *make ourselves* Jesus' close relatives by doing the will of His heavenly Father. Rather, doing the Father's will *identifies* us as His mother and sisters and brothers. The doing of that will turns on obedience to Jesus and His teachings, according to Matthew, for it was Jesus who preeminently revealed the will of the Father."
