

STORY:

Poor Naaman.
He has owies.
Owies on his face.
Owies on his arms.
Owies on his hands.
Owies on his legs.
Owies everywhere!

Naaman's daddy cannot help him. Naaman's mommy cannot help him. The doctor cannot help Naaman. Only God can help Naaman.

Naaman went to see Elisha. Elisha loved God. God knew what to do. "Wash in the river water seven times," said Elisha.

Seven times!

Let's wash in the water like Naaman. One, two, three, four, five, six, seven. Seven times Naaman washed in the water. Just like God said.

And Naaman's owies were gone.
He had no owies on his face.
No owies on his arms.
No owies on his hands.
No owies on his legs.
God took away Naaman's owies!

Show Naaman (picture 6A).

Point to his spots, which are the owies or sores, and to your own arms, hands, and legs.

(Note: If your children don't understand the word "owies," you may want to use another word such as "hurts.")

Shake your head "no."

Point up.

Show Elisha (picture 6b). Nod your head "yes."

Show Namaan in the river (picture 6c).

Duck down seven times pretending to wash in the river.

Show picture 6d.

Point up.

STORY CONTINUED:

Naaman said, "There is only one God!" God is great! God is strong! God is good. There is only one God. Show one finger. Show Naaman again (6d). Make a strong gesture.

Show one finger.

REVIEW:

Could Naaman's daddy help him? [no]
Could Naaman's mommy help him? [no]
Who could help Naaman? [God]
Did God help Naaman? [yes]
God took away all Naaman's owies.
God is good!
God is strong!
How many gods are there? [one]
There is one God.

SING:

(Review songs from past lessons.)

FINGERPLAY:

Just one God. Not two. Not three. Not four. Just one God. Show one finger.

Shake head "no" showing two fingers, three fingers, four fingers.

Show one finger.

PRAY:

Thank God for taking Naaman's owies away.
Thank God that He is strong and good.
Praise God that He is the only God. ("You are the only God.")

Work on the scripture memory verses and/or Foundation Verses.
