We will be adding 10 new slots to each of the worship services at 9 am and 10:30 am for a total of 35 open slots per service. We initially started with 25 per service to ensure that the plan that we had in place for the space at RTS would work well for our present circumstance. After worshipping for 3 weeks and seeing what the room and our plan can handle, we believe each service can easily handle 10 more people with minimal increased risk to those serving and attending. We will reassess this plan and any other pertinent information weekly to see if we need to make alterations to our current plan, so stay flexible!

Again, please do not attend if you have any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19 or have recently tested positive even if asymptomatic. Don't worry about taking up a slot if you are unable to come. We would rather you err on the side of caution.

We will continue with our online worship for those who are at higher risk or aren't quite ready to get back together in-person for worship. The services will be the same format and elements so that we can continue to grow in God's Word together as a church.

Given the continued risks related to COVID-19, we will continue with the following protocol at RTS Atlanta:

1. The address is **1580 Terrell Mill Road SE, Marietta, Ga 30067**. The Express Lane runs south on Sunday mornings and has an exit on Terrill Mill Road near RTS. Park in front of RTS.

Please arrive 5-10 minutes prior to start of the service you signed up for so as to have adequate time to get in the building and get seated.

2. You will enter through the door on the left side as you face the building. We will have it propped open and someone outside to greet you. We will allow one family in at a time spaced appropriately to maintain social distancing as you enter the building.

3. You will need to wear a mask as you enter the building and keep it on any time that you are walking about or standing in worship for responding and singing. You are free to remove your mask when seated for the pastoral prayer and the sermon should you choose. You will need to wear your mask as you exit the building and can remove it in the parking lot. We will have spare masks available in case you forget yours.

4. You will move through the lobby into the chapel to be seated by one of our ushers. We will seat you from back to front with the rows staggered on each side of the room to allow greater than the recommended social distance between rows. We will add chairs to rows should you need them. Remember to ask single folks to sit with you on your row as you feel comfortable. You can also sit together with couples to fill a row as you are comfortable.

5. Separate childcare will not be provided at this time so they will be in worship with us. Children 5 years old and up will need to wear a mask as stated above.

6. The bathrooms are available as you need them. Please wear your mask to and from the bathroom.

7. When the service concludes, the ushers will release you row by row with facing left hand side of the room exiting back to front out the back door, and the facing right hand side of the room exiting out the front door from front to back.

8. You are free to fellowship with one another in the parking lot or invite folks to brunch or lunch in some creative way.
