# "THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT: FAITHFULNESS" LUKE 19:11-27 CAMERON BARHAM

Key Truth: We love God and our neighbors by faithfully investing the Gospel that Jesus entrusted to us in our spheres of influence for God's glory and the life of the world.

#### Introduction:

Q: What role did someone else's faithfulness in the Gospel in word and deed play in your becoming a Christian?

**Faithfulness**: Because God is to be trusted to fulfill His promises to His people through the person and work of Christ, we seek to hallow God's name in the vows we've made in His name and to prove trustworthy and true to our commitments to our neighbors

in the sustaining work of the Holy Spirit.

#### Luke 19:11-27: The Investment of the Faithful and the Guaranteed Returns:

"To each of His followers the Saviour has given the glad tidings of redemption through Him, so that each one may, as it were, make it bear interest—may cause its beneficent operation to spread through the whole world. Every believer must be faithfully employed in this work for the extension of His sovereign dominion on earth until He comes back."

Q: What has the Lord entrusted to you to be faithful with for His glory for the life of the world? Are you more concerned with keeping what you currently have or risking it for the sake of the growth of the Kingdom and the glory of the King?

#### Application:
