## GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Read *John 11:1-6*. Why did Jesus say, "This illness does not lead to death. It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it"?
- 2) Why do people fear death? Why do they fear what will happen after we die?
- 3) Read *John 11:17*. Why did Jesus wait for 4 days after Lazarus had died before coming to him?
- 4) Read *John 11:18-22*. How did Martha respond to Jesus? What would you have done in her situation?
- 5) Read *John 11:23-27; 14:19; 1 John 5:13*. How can we know for certain that Christians will be in heaven when we die?
- 6) In a season of fear, when it comes to the truth of the resurrection, why should Christians be fearless? How can you live a fearless life right now?

### FOR YOUR FAMILY

- 1) Memorize *John 10:9 – Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes I in Me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"*
- 2) Read *John 11:1-6*. Discuss with your family why Jesus was not in a hurry to run and heal Lazarus.
- 3) Read *John 11:17-27*. Talk with your family about the importance of Jesus being the resurrection and the life and what that means for you and me.
