GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Have you ever felt alone with people all around?
- 2) Explore a time when you felt you had a great task or "commission" and you felt all alone to accomplish that task.
- 3) Read *Deuteronomy 31:6*. It seems as if God relates being afraid with being alone. Think of a present-day fear in your life. How would God's promise of being with you change that fear?
- 4) Read *John 15:4-5*. How have you found that you have struggled to "bear fruit" at times in your life as a time that you did not stay connected to God?
- 5) Do you have enough solitude in your life? How can you be still and have solitude and yet not be lonely?
- 6) Read *Hebrews 13:5*. How is the love of money and/or being content related to the truth that "He will never leave you or forsake you"?

FOR YOUR FAMILY

- 1) Memorize "The Great Commission", *Matthew 28:19-20*: *"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*
- 2) What can you do when you feel alone? How would school work and home be different if we were aware that He is with us?
- 3) Are you surprised that God trusts you to be a part of His great plan of redemption?
